Dear Parents and Carers,

I am sure that you either watched the Prime Minister's address to the nation last night or have seen the headlines in the press this morning.

During the announcement the Prime Minister stated that schools may partially reopen on 1 June 2020. It appears that this would be initially for the children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 6.

I know that parents will inevitably have a range of questions regarding the reopening of school. Like you I have only seen the announcement and at this stage I cannot answer all of your questions. I am waiting to receive more information from the government and what this means for Foxmoor Primary School.

In the short term nothing has changed. Foxmoor will still be providing provision for the key worker and vulnerable children that have already been attending school.
