

Music at Foxmoor Primary School

All children at Foxmoor participate in music lessons from Reception to Year Six in a fun and engaging environment under the guidance of a specialist music teacher. Throughout the school year, each class will have the opportunity to work together and as individuals in composing, transcribing, describing and performing in music, the four main key features of music in school.

Every child has the chance to sing at Foxmoor during a weekly hour-long class music lesson as well as through whole key stage singing practice. They will learn to sing in unison, rounds and with simple harmonization in a range of styles with upbeat songs and actions with thought provoking lyrics.

All children, in both key stages, will experience playing musical instruments; a range of tuned and un-tuned percussion instruments such as the glockenspiel, recorder, drums and shakers. They will also have the prospect of learning strings, woodwind, brass, guitar, drums and piano with a peripatetic instrumental teacher. Children taking instrumental lessons benefit from participating in the brass band, orchestra or instrumental club.

All children perform at least once a year to parents and the public, showcasing a high standard of musical ability.
