

## PSHE Curriculum Statement

At Foxmoor Primary School the intent of our PSHE curriculum is to deliver a curriculum which is accessible to all and that will maximise the outcomes for every child so that they know more, remember more and understand more. As a result of this they will become healthy, independent and responsible members of society who understand how they are developing personally and socially. It will give them confidence to tackle many of the moral, social and cultural issues that are part of growing up. We provide our children with opportunities for them to learn about rights and responsibilities and appreciate what it means to be a member of a diverse society. Our children are encouraged to develop their sense of self-worth by playing a positive role in contributing to school life and the wider community.

Our PSHE Curriculum is a whole school approach so that different year groups will be working on the same themes at the same time throughout the year. This allows for collaboration between the classes and enables us to link the PSHE curriculum to our whole school assemblies. This whole school approach allows teachers to plan and build a programme of learning that develops year on year allowing children to build on what they know and deepen their understanding.

The three core themes of our curriculum are:

- Health and Wellbeing
- Relationships
- Living in the Wider World

In EYFS a whole class sharing book records their responses to PSHE sessions. In KS1 and KS2 children record their thoughts, ideas and experiences in their own PSHE book which travels with them as they move through each year group.

At Foxmoor we believe that PSHE plays a vital part in the education of the children in our care. Regular sessions will be planned throughout the term and cross curricular links will be made when possible and appropriate; enabling full coverage of the PSHE scheme of work. Alongside this, there will also be occasions where staff teach PSHE as a result of an issue which has arisen in their own class.

At Foxmoor we believe PSHE is integral to the development of children's values in order for them to become a positive citizen in a forever changing community.
