

Dear Parents and Carers,

The governors and I have just concluded a meeting and due to staffing restrictions we have taken the decision to switch to remote learning for the first two weeks of the spring term. This will be kept under review and I will communicate any changes to you as necessary.

The school and Little Foxes Nursery will be closed to all children on Monday 4<sup>th</sup> and Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> but it is our intention to offer provision in school for key worker and vulnerable children from Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> January. I will write to you again tomorrow to confirm these arrangements.

Remote learning will be set via our teachers2parents email service tomorrow morning. Please check your junk mail folder if have not received it by 9.30am. Remote learning will be monitored and we expect all children to complete the work set. Communication between home and the class teacher will be via the class email address so if you have any questions regarding work or need any further clarification then please email. The email address will be monitored from 8am till 4pm daily. Teachers or teaching assistants will also make weekly telephone calls to families whose children are remote learning. The governors and I appreciate that this is very short notice and it is not a decision that we have taken lightly. However, having received notification of staffing levels this afternoon we feel that we have no alternative.
